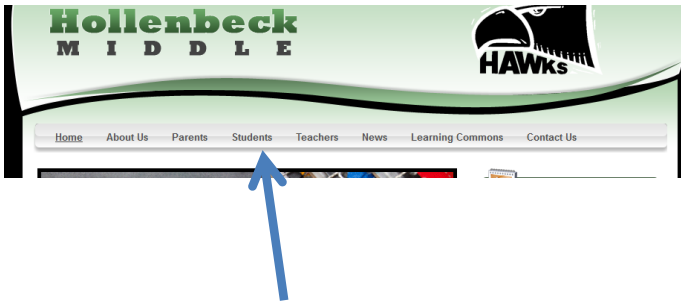


PARENT/CHILD ACCESS TO PEARSON REALIZE

1. Log in with the user name and password from the link titled “Pearson EasyBridge” on your school’s homepage under the Students tab.

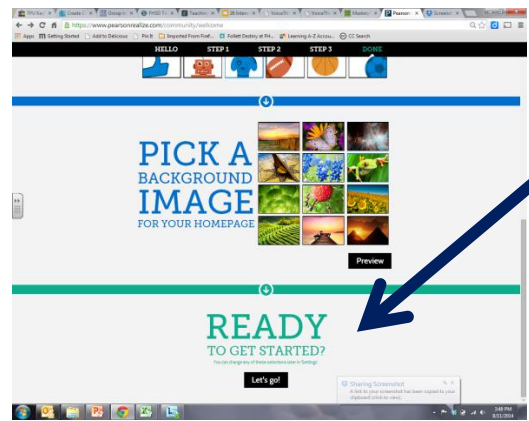
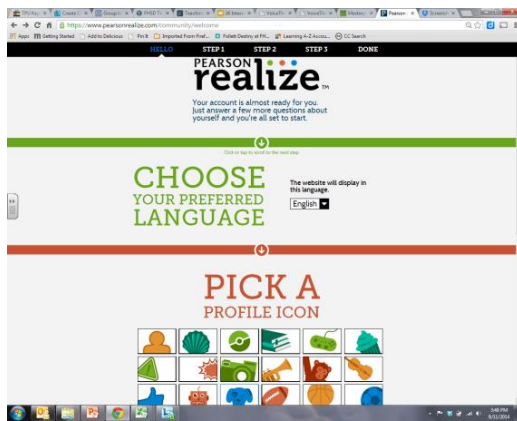

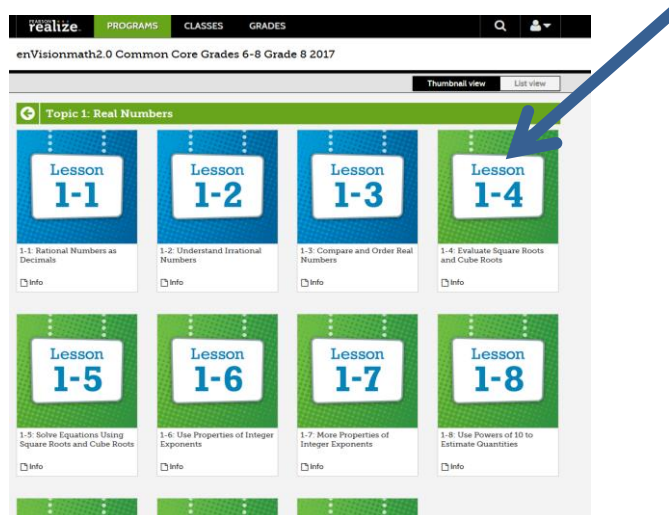
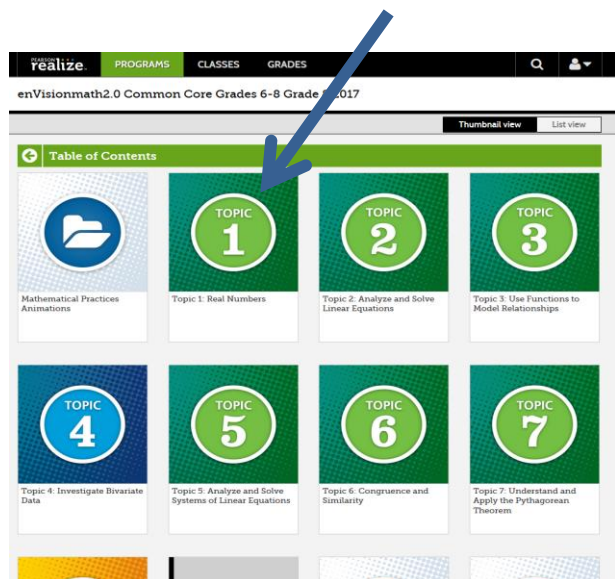
2. Select your preferred language, icon preference, and background preferences. Then click, “Let’s Go!”



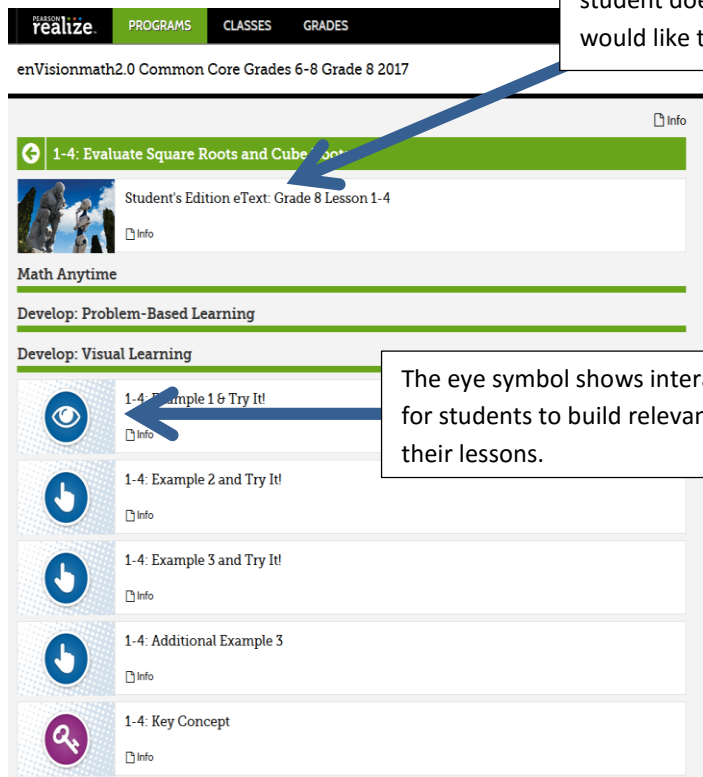
3. You will be taken to a screen that shows:
 - a. Programs your child has access to
 - b. Assignment due dates, if applicable
 - c. Grades for assignments, if applicable
4. If your child has assignments, they will be shown in the main area of the page. Teachers can assign online homework, re-teaching assignments, the Math Anytime practice problems, Quick Checks, and videos to students. After choosing the red box, you will be taken to a screen that shows all assignments and due dates listed. To gain access to math tools and glossary, go to the side bar on the right.



5. After your first login, you will enter the program to automatically see the programs your child can access. To gain access to videos (same as your child sees in class), click on your child's grade level program, then the topic your child is currently studying. If you do not know the topic, it can be found at the top of any homework assignment the student brings home printed from the program.



Student Edition eText is available online if your student doesn't have his/her text at home or you would like to see what they are learning.



The eye symbol shows interactive videos for students to build relevance during their lessons.

Virtual Nerd lessons help students who need support during homework time. These videos align to the classroom learning activities.
