Activity Fees:

The FHSD Board of Education has approved the recommendation of the Extracurricular Task Force to establish an activity fee structure for the 2019-20 school year. Students participating in a sport, activity, or club - in which a sponsor or coach is paid a stipend - will be required to pay a yearly activity fee. Students will be assessed one fee regardless of how many sports/activities/clubs they participate in during the school year. An application for financial assistance/waiver will be available for students, as needed.

*Additional team and club assessments will still apply.

Based on participation data from previous years, the activity fee would generate approximately \$200,000 annually that will go to the general revenue fund. This revenue will help to prevent further reductions in the number of extra-curricular activities, or the number of contests during an activity or sport season.
